
PROBLEM STATEMENT

- Due to Braamfontein's proximity to higher educational institutions, it has become popular among students seeking student accommodation.
- There are six general practitioners and two private clinics, with an average basic consultation fee of 400 Rands excluding prescribed medication.
- A focus group of students living in Braamfontein showed that students in Braamfontein encounter a financial shortfall unless they receive assistance from the government or bursary schemes.
- Besides Wits and UJ, which provide free primary healthcare services for their students, Students residing in Braamfontein have to travel to the nearest Public primary healthcare facility (Hillbrow Clinic), Five Kilometers away, or pay a consultation fee, with additional costs for the prescribed medication.





For the sake of this project primary healthcare is considered as the first point of contact for individuals seeking medical assistance. Primary health care is defined as essential health care based on practical, scientifically sound and socially acceptable methods and technology, made universally accessible to individuals and families in the community at a cost that the community and country can afford to maintain at every stage of their development.



BRAAMFONTEIN CULTURE










Symbol

The Red Cross dates back to the 1800s and was used as an an identifier for medical personnel during wartime. Today, the red cross symbol came to be a recognizable generic emblem for medicine, commonly associated with first aid, medical services, products, or professionals



I added a modern twist on the normal cross to emphasise dynamism and communicate to a young and modern target market

Type face, Font

Sans Serif: Also referred to as "grotesque", sans serif fonts are viewed as modern, airy and minimalist, sans serif typefaces are made of simple thin lines that look great across websites and apps. the font is legible both online and for print (even when reduced)

Bold: The word "student" is in bold to emphasise the focus on students

Grey: According to UX This prevents overstimulating the retina and allows users to read for a more extended period.

WAYFINDING AND SIGNANGE

The icon system in place serves as a valuable tool for patients and visitors in navigating the complex medical environment. The use of recognizable and simple iconography bridges the gap between medical terminology and the general public, reducing confusion and minimizing stress. The majority of the symbols employed were designed by the author, while some were sourced from standardized symbols such as the AIGA, with minor modifications. In creating such systems, I tried to refrain from creating new designs when effective and widely understood symbols already exist. This approach reduces confusion and promotes ease of use for all users.






























PERSPECTIVE OF WAITING AREA- GROUND FLOOR
